

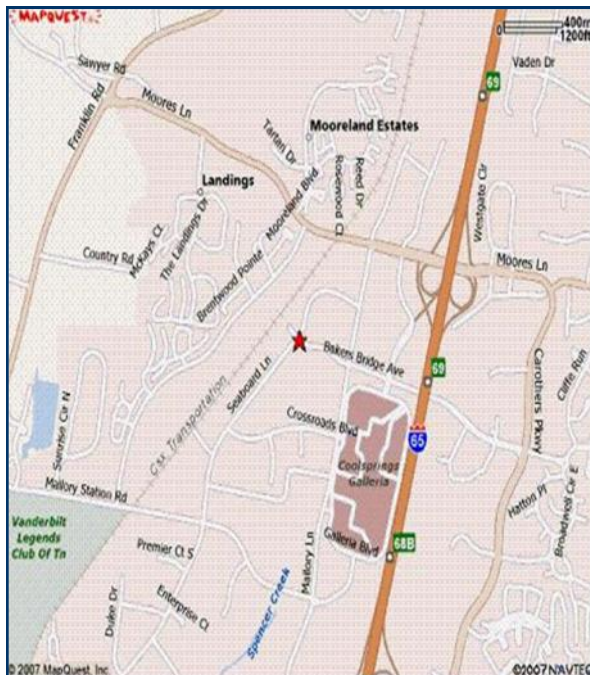

Habitat ReStore of Williamson County serves the community by accepting donated items that are useful, but wanted, and by providing a tax deductible receipt for donors.

We help serve donors who are:

- Homeowners who have recently remodeled or renovated their homes
- Contractors with surplus materials and demolition crews salvaging useful building materials
- Suppliers who have discontinued or returned items that can't be sold, or returned to the manufacturer or wholesaler



DONATIONS

We accept:

New or gently used items in ready-to-use condition.

Cabinets - up to date, little to no damage
Windows-complete units only
Lumber-at least 6' sections, no nails or rot
Doors- please remove all hardware
Roofing - no open packages, no scraps
Carpet - no stains, no odors, and no holes
Tools - hand, garden and working power tools
Flooring - wood (clean) ceramic tile, vinyl
Millwork/trim- wood casing, clean base (at least 6 foot sections)
Ceramic Tile (minimum 40 sq ft)
Appliances - clean and working, under 7 years
Furniture - no rips, tears, holes, stains or odors
Household décor- framed pictures, tables, chairs, collectibles (no glassware, plates or pots and pans)

Items we cannot sell:

Toxic materials of any kind, lead based paint
Open paint or materials
Non working tools, appliances and electronics
Clothing, books, cast iron tubs, broken glass

All donations are tax deductible.

We reserve the right to decline certain materials we deem unusable.....
