Dear Friend of Habitat for Humanity,

As a friend of Habitat for Humanity, I would like to let you know about an opportunity to tell the Habitat story to the local community and raise significant funds for the organization. Our goal this year is to raise \$125,000 through this event. On Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, Habitat for Humanity of Williamson County will host the 2006 **Habitee Golf Challenge** at The Governors Club with a 12:00 noon shotgun start. The golf challenge event is a vehicle through which players “raise funds and raise friends” to support the vision of Habitat for Humanity. We do this by recruiting captains and players who will commit to mailing or emailing a sponsorship letter and a Habitat brochure to at least 50 people. A sample letter will be provided along with the Habitat brochure.

If you or someone you know enjoys golf and would be willing to join us as a Captain, your commitment would be as follows:

1. **To recruit 3 more players** for your team. If you were not going to play, recruit 4 players and you would be the non-playing captain and the 5<sup>th</sup> fundraiser of the team.
2. **To explain** to your team members the importance of **the fundraising process** and the long-term value of raising friends as well as funds for Habitat for Humanity of Williamson County. All the materials needed for this process will be provided to each player.
3. To attend the **Captain’s meeting on Thursday, May 25<sup>th</sup> at The Governors Club. We will begin with a group golf lesson from Head Pro, Scott Bailey, starting at 5:15 pm followed by our Captain’s Meeting from 6:00 to 7:00 pm.**
4. To bring your team members and their spouses to a **Special Tee-Off Event on Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup> at the home of Steve & Carol Prince from 6:30 to 8:00 pm.**
5. Come and play in the **Habitee Golf Challenge on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> at The Governors Club for a noon shotgun start.**

Thank you for your consideration in joining us for this golf challenge as a captain or as an individual player. I would be happy to include you as a part of another team if you cannot be a captain. You will be receiving a call from one of our golf committee members in the next few days to help answer any questions.
